

Day 1: Arrival in Delhi

- Arrive in Delhi and check into your hotel.
- Culinary tour in Old Delhi's Chandni Chowk.
- Visit the lesser-known Agrasen ki Baoli, an ancient stepwell hidden amidst the urban chaos.
- Overnight stay in Delhi.

Day 2: Delhi Exploration

- Explore the offbeat Hauz Khas Village, a blend of trendy cafes, boutiques, and historical ruins.
- Guided tour of Delhi / heritage walk
- Free time to explore on your own
- Overnight stay in Delhi.

Day 3: Delhi to Agra

- Drive / Train from Delhi to Agra (approx. 3-4 hours).
- Visit the Taj Mahal and the lesser-known Mehtab Bagh, offering stunning views of the Taj Mahal at sunset.
- Explore the local markets and indulge in Agra's street food delights/ culinary walk
- Free time to explore on your own
- Overnight stay in Agra.

Day 4: Agra to Ranthambhore

- Early morning drive from Agra to Ranthambhore (approx. 5-6 hours).
- Enjoy an offbeat experience with a visit to the Ranthambhore School of Art, interacting with local artists and learning about traditional art forms. (Experience option)
- Overnight stay in Ranthambhore.

Day 5: Ranthambhore Safari

- Embark on an early morning safari in Ranthambhore National Park, famous for its tiger sightings.
- Explore the Ranthambhore Fort, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and soak in panoramic views of the park.
- Visit the lesser-known Surwal Lake for birdwatching and tranquil surroundings.
- Overnight stay in Ranthambhore.

Day 6: Ranthambhore to Bundi

- Drive from Ranthambhore to Bundi (approx. 4-5 hours).
- Explore the offbeat Taragarh Fort, known for its stunning views and intricate frescoes.
- Visit the lesser-known Raniji ki Baori, an ancient stepwell adorned with beautiful carvings.
- Overnight stay in Bundi.



Day 7: Bundi to Udaipur

- Early drive from Bundi to Udaipur (approx. 5-6 hours).
- Lunch in Udaipur
- Explore the offbeat Shilpgram, a rural arts and crafts complex showcasing traditional Rajasthani culture.
- Enjoy a boat ride on the serene Dudh Talai Lake and admire the sunset views.
- Overnight stay in Udaipur

Day 8: Udaipur Exploration

- Visit the lesser-known Saheliyon ki Bari, a beautiful garden adorned with fountains and marble pavilions.
- Guided tour of Udaipur forts and palaces
- Explore the offbeat Vintage Car Museum, showcasing a unique collection of classic cars and royal carriages. (option)
- Visit the lesser-known Jagdish Temple, known for its stunning architecture and intricate carvings. (option)
- · Overnight stay in Udaipur.

Day 9: Udaipur to Jodhpur

- Drive from Udaipur to Jodhpur (approx. 4-5 hours).
- Explore the lesser-known Rao Jodha Desert Rock Park, a conservation area with walking trails and panoramic views of Mehrangarh Fort.
- Visit the lesser-known Toorji ka Jhalra, a historic stepwell hidden in the heart of the city.
- Overnight stay in Jodhpur.



Day 10: Jodhpur Exploration

- Explore the offbeat Mandore Gardens, featuring ancient cenotaphs and lush greenery.
- Visit the lesser-known Jaswant Thada, a white marble memorial with intricate carvings and serene surroundings.
- Free time to explore the local markets and indulge in Jodhpur's culinary delights.
- Overnight stay in Jodhpur.

Day 11: Jodhpur to Jaipur

- Drive from Jodhpur to Jaipur (approx. 5-6 hours).
- Explore the offbeat Anokhi Museum of Hand Printing, showcasing the art of block printing.
- Visit the lesser-known Galta Ji Temple, also known as the Monkey Temple, nestled amidst the Aravalli Hills.
- Overnight stay in Jaipur.

Day 12: Jaipur Exploration

- Guided tour of Jaipur
- Free time to explore the city on your own
- Overnight stay in Jaipur

Day 13: Jaipur to Delhi

• Early flight back to Delhi, then back home from Delhi after 4pm


