


DEJA VU - HISTORY REPEATS ITSELF

Aihole is well-known for about 125 stone templates dating back to the 5th century CE.Kings were crowned and commemorated in Pattadakal ("Stone of Coronation") and it was considered to be a holy place and one of a kind in India.

Shravanbelagola is home to over 2,300 years of Jain heritage and is famous for its massive 57-ft high statue of the Jain god Bahubali. Every 12 years, thousands of devotees congregate here to perform the Mahamastakabhisheka, a spectacular ceremony in which the statue is washed and anointed with spices and gold and silver flowers. The next such event will be held in 2030. This region spans architecture from 600 to 1830 AD.

Located on the banks of river Tungabhadra, Hampi was once the capital of the Vijayanagar Empire (somewhere between 1336 – 1565 AD) and one of the richest and largest cities in the world during its prime and is now in ruins.

Mysore was the capital of the Kingdom of Mysore from 1399 to 1947. In its center is the opulent Mysore Palace, seat of the former ruling Vodeyar dynasty.




